

Available to students who are enthusiastic and reliable contributors to all facets of life, the All Rounder Scholarship aims to provide educational opportunity to students who would be considered by their peers to be a visible role model of holistic education.

Successful students will have a strong academic record, with demonstrated strengths and interests in a broad number of areas such as community service, culture, sport and academia. The extent of all-round contribution to the School will distinguish this student.

Students are required to sit the Academic Scholarship examination.

The All Rounder Scholarship is open to new and current students looking to enter Years 5 to 10 in 2021, and is tenable until the end of Year 12.

*The All Rounder Scholarship is a means tested scholarship. The award of the All Rounder Scholarship will preference students who, for financial or other reasons, cannot attend or continue their studies at St Michael's Grammar School.



All Rounder Scholarship Overview

Criteria for awarding scholarship

The All Rounder Scholarship is awarded to student/s entering Year 5 to 10 in 2021.

The Scholars will be individuals who:

- are enthusiastic and reliable contributors to all facets of life, in and outside of school.
- demonstrate all-round contribution, strengths and interest in a broad number of areas such as community service, culture, sport and academia.
- demonstrate strong academic potential and academic performance.
- share the School's values of Dignity, Respect, Care and Compassion.
- will embrace the School's culture of contributing citizenship and reciprocity.
- will gain from and engage with the diverse range of programs offered by the School.
- will contribute positively to the School and the broader community.

Specific application criteria:

- 1. Applicants will complete the applicant statement.
- Applicants will score results between Stanine 6-9 in all the School's Academic Scholarship examination categories.
- 3. Applicants will show strong and consistent results in their learning (via documented School Reports, NAPLAN and/or standardised test results).
- 4. Applicants will provide a statement of financial position as part of the application process as this is a compulsory means tested scholarship.
- 5. Prior to a scholarship offer being made, short-listed applicants would need to provide further financial supporting documentation to satisfy the means-testing criteria set by the School.

St Michael's Grammar School Scholarship program operates subject to the School's Scholarship Policy. Scholarships are awarded at the discretion of the Head of the School, and the Scholarship holder is subject to all terms and condition of enrolment.

Costs covered by the scholarship

Tuition remission offered based on results of application criteria and assessment of the family's financial position in the St Michael's Grammar School means-testing criteria.

Remission of costs of Enrolment including the Registration fee, Confirmation of Enrolment Fee, and Advance of School Fees will also be based on results of application criteria and assessment of the family's financial position in the St Michael's Grammar School means-testing criteria.

Costs not covered by the scholarship

All additional and associated costs which pertain to the student's education.

Role of the School

The School will provide places to scholarship recipients at agreed discount rate. The scholarship offer is not negotiable.

The School will advertise the scholarship opportunity to prospective students, short-list applications and award scholarships.

Subject to funding availability, this scholarship is awarded to a student or students currently attending, or not yet at the School.
